 - Open to only Black belt
- * Qualification of Contestants
 - Family Pair: Two (2) generations family members only
 - Must be composed of two generations of direct family members regardless of gender (Father and Son, Father and Daughter, Mother and Son, Mother and Daughter) In this case, siblings are not available.
 - Family Team: Three (3) generations family members only
 - Must be composed of three generations of direct family members regardless of gender (Grand Father/Grand Mother and Father/Mother and Son/Daughter)
 - In case of Family Division (Pair & Team), open to all age groups among family members

- 9.1 WT Poomsae Competition Rules in force as of May 14th, 2019 shall apply.
- 9.2 The video will be scored in accordance with the Online Scoring Criteria.
- 9.3 The first and second Poomsae must be performed by order.
- 9.4 The videos of the first and second Poomsae should be recorded separately While recording a video, the contestant must be on the screen till he/she finishes his/her first and second Poomsae.
- 9.5 Any video editing means automatic disqualification.
- 9.6 Any violation of the video registration method and video recording guideline provided by WT Asia will result in disqualification.

10.2 Cut-off System

- 10.2.1 Preliminaries: In case twenty (20) or more contestants are participating, the competition shall start from preliminary round with division of groups. (It can be adjusted according to the number of contestants). The top half of each group shall advance to semi-final based on the points.
- 10.2.2 **Semi-final**: In case nine (9) to nineteen (19) contestants are participating, competition shall start from semi-final. Top eight (8) contestants advance to final based on the points.
- 10.2.3 **Final**: In case eight (8) or less contestants are participating, competition shall start from final round. Top four (4) contestants shall be awarded based on the points. Bronze medals shall be given to the 3rd and the 4th contestants.
- 10.2.4 Duration of contest: Within 90 seconds

10.4 Cut-off System

- 10.4.1 Preliminaries: In case twenty (20) or more contestants are participating, the competition shall start from preliminary round with division of groups. (It can be adjusted according to the number of contestants). The top half of each group shall advance to semi-final based on the points.
- 10.4.2 **Semi-final**: In case nine (9) to nineteen (19) contestants are participating, competition shall start from semi-final. Top eight (8) contestants advance to final based on the points.
- 10.4.3 **Final**: In case eight (8) or less contestants are participating, competition shall start from final round. Top four (4) contestants shall be awarded based on the points. Bronze medals shall be given to the 3rd and the 4th contestants.
- 10.4.4 **Duration of contest**: Within 90 seconds

[Competition (Free Style) Poomsae]

- 10.5 Yeon-mu line and music shall be decided by the contestant.
- 10.6 All techniques shall be performed in the camera angle.
- 10.7 The five techniques designated by WT Poomsae Committee must be included in the techniques to be performed. Also, those techniques can be replaced as below: (Five Demonstration Techniques: Jumping side kick, Multiple kicks in a jump, Gradient of spins in a spin kick, Consecutive kicks, and Acrobatic kicking technique)
- 10.7.1 Jumping side kick: Jumping High Kick, Jumping Front Kick, Jumping Round Kick, Jumping Spin Kick, Jumping Back Kick and Jumping Open-Spread Kick
- 10.7.2 Multiple kicks in a jump: Jumping Multi-step Kick, Multi-step Round Kick, Multi-step Side Kick and Multi-step Scissors Kick
- 10.7.3 Gradient of spins in a spin kick: Horizontal Rotation Kick, Back Slap Kick, Back Slap Multi-step Kick and Spin Kick
- 10.7.4 Consecutive kicks
- 10.7.5 Acrobatic kicking technique

10.8 Cut-off system

- 10.8.1 **Preliminaries**: In case twenty (20) or more contestants are participating, the competition shall start from preliminary round with division of groups. (It can be adjusted according to the number of contestants).
- 10.8.2 **Semi-final**: In case nine (9) to nineteen (19) contestants are participating, competition shall start from semi-final. Top eight (8) contestants advance to final based on the points.
- 10.8.3 **Final**: In case eight (8) or less contestants are participating, competition shall start from final round. Top four (4) contestants shall be awarded based on the points. Bronze medals shall be given to the 3rd and the 4th contestants.
- 10.8.4 **Duration of contest**: from 90 to 100 seconds



11 * Awards

- 11.1 Medals & Certificates:
 - 1st place: Gold medal(s) and certificate(s)
 - 2nd place: Silver medal(s) and certificate(s)
 - 3rd place and 4th place: Bronze medal(s) and certificate(s)
- 11.2 Participation Online Certificate: All Participants

12 * Uniform

All contestants must wear the WT-recognized Poomsae competition uniforms. If contestants don't have the WT-recognized Poomsae competition uniforms, they can wear any white colored uniform.

- * Guidelines for Video Recording (It might be changed or added later.)
- 13.1 When the contestant performs Poomsae,
- 13.1.1 Install the camera 6m apart from the contestant (recommended), and 115-120cm above the ground
- 13.1.2 Available to move the camera to either side within the limit of 3m on the mat so that the whole body of the contestant can be seen in the camera angle
- 13.1.3 Not allowed to edit or manipulate the video
- 13.1.4 Must record the video to be seen the front of the contestant without zooming in or out the image
- 13.1.5 Setting the camera frame as below

- Android: FHD 16:9

- iPhone: 1080p HD, 30fps

- 13.2 The video can be recorded regardless of time and place. Please strictly observe the guidelines of the local and national health authorities when you go out to record video. Any political, economic, cultural and social issues involved in the video means automatic disqualification.
- 13.3 All contestants must always be inside the camera. Using substitutes means automatic disqualification.
- 13.4 Points will be deducted as follows:
- 13.4.1 When any part of the body is cut-off by the video frame, 0.3 points deduction will apply for every Poom movement each time.
- 13.4.2 When whole body is cut-off by the video frame, 0.6 points deduction will apply for every Poom movement in each time.
- 13.5 You can display the IOC-approved flag as a background or use the flag as an emoji.
- 13.6 Protective equipment, taping, and shoes cannot be worn when recording video.
- 13.7 Do not leave the video angle from the preparation to the end of performance.
- 13.8 Any sound other than Kihap should not be heard during the performance.
- 13.9 Before performing, you should make comments. (Mission comment
- title of championships, country, division, title of Poomsae, contestant's name in order).
